- The 5-year contract with Everbridge is complete. WENS, the new mass notification system has been purchased on a three-year contract for \$35,000. Due to the decreased cost, it is no longer a cost share to the communities. For the next week, we will be working on setting it up and will then start training users of the system such as Medina City and Wadsworth. It has some new features that were not available in Everbridge.
