- We received the following spill report since the last meeting
 - 7/27/18: Ohio Edison, 2321 Ridge Rd Hinckley, 1 gallon of transformer oil into swamp
 - 7/31/18: All Days Transport, 100+ gallons diesel fuel & 17- 750 liter totes of glue, I-271 NB North of I-71, MVA
 - 8/8/18: Circle K in Seville, Unknown amount of gasoline into storm drain due to human error
 - 8/16/18: Ohio Edison, 210 gallons of transformer oil into creek on W. Smith rd. Medina
- One 30-day follow-up report(s) were received
