- **Chief Walters called the meeting to order at 11:24am**
- **No public comments.**

- **Old Business**
 - **Chippewa Lake Station Update.**
 - B. Nau provided a building update. Contract signed. Construction starts on March 21st. \$752,000.00 Building to be completed by end of June.
 - C. Stiver provided information that equipment from Chippewa is being moved to LTFD during construction. One truck, trailers, and mobile command.
 - **Camera Transfer**
 - C. Stiver advised the camera transfer has occurred. Cameras are in excellent condition. Total value \$23,000.00
 - Region V will be assigning a 360 camera to Medina County.
 - \$13065.00 that was budgeted for FL360 System will be reallocated to capital budget.
