The Medina County Emergency Management Agency Executive Committee met in regular session on January 21, 2026, approving the following:

**RESOLUTION DECLARING MEDINA COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
AGENCY PROPERTY AS EXCESS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee of the Medina County Emergency Management Agency (hereinafter "MCEMA") acknowledges that the MCEMA has two decontamination tents with heaters, property ID numbers HM-001 and HM-002, that are no longer needed for public use.

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee finds that the decontamination tents and heaters are declared excess property and authorizes the MCEMA to transfer ownership to Lafayette Township Fire and Rescue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Committee of the MCEMA that the decontamination tents and heaters, property ID numbers HM-001 and HM-002, are declared excess property and the MCEMA is authorized to transfer the items to Lafayette Township Fire and Rescue.
