**PURCHASE OF A HEAVY RESCUE TRUCK FROM THE CITY OF WADSWORTH**

**WHEREAS**, Medina County EMA is responsible for maintaining response capabilities for hazardous materials incidents in Medina County; and


**WHEREAS**, and the Hazardous Materials Response Team currently operates out of 2 gooseneck trailers; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wadsworth has offered a (1999 Pierce/Navistar International 4900, VIN: 1HTSDADR3YH227789, Miles: 6,616.3) for \$35,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the All Hazards Advisory Committee has determined it will improve operational and response capability of the team to move the equipment into a truck; and

**WHEREAS**, the All Hazards Advisory Committee has approved a resolution recommending the purchase of the vehicle at the June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026 meeting; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Executive Committee of the MCEMA that the EMA purchase the 1999 Pierce/Navistar International 4900, VIN: 1HTSDADR3YH227789 from the City of Wadsworth for \$35,000.
